2003-2004 CEL Program Commitment Form**

To ensure a successful CEL program that is consistent with the philosophy, I (we) agree to participate in the CEL (Community Enhanced Learning) Program at Monta Loma School by fulfilling the parent participation requirements outlined below and in the CEL Program Handbook and Policy Manual.

Children and parents may participate in the CEL Program if the parent(s) meet(s) the following requirements:

1. Meet state tuberculosis (TB) testing requirements (once every four years).
2. Attend CEL program orientation.
3. Complete a one-time parent aide training workshop.
4. Provide a minimum of five hours per month of classroom aide time by parent or surrogate OR work out an alternative way to help out the teacher/classroom (example prep time) during evenings or weekends. For two or more children in the program, parents should provide a minimum of eight hours per month.
5. Work a minimum of two hours per month for Monta Loma School in general. For two or more children, the minimum is three hours per month.
6. Participate in a CEL classroom and/or CEL program job such as classroom coordinator, technology committee member, steering committee member, etc.
7. Attend monthly evening meetings with teacher and/or speaker.
8. Satisfy a fundraising obligation of \$150 (or \$250 for two or more children), either through buyout or running a fundraiser. (CEL is open to anyone interested in the goals of the program, regardless of ability to pay. The fundraising obligation will be waived in cases of financial hardship.)
