SIOP: writing and posting language objectives. We've reclassified 8 students in the fall. There's an ELD intervention teacher/class and time.</p> <p>ELA/Math: RTI is our major program to address ELA needs. The key strategies in math is more small group instruction time.</p>	<p>In the next several meetings, we will look at the site plan and safety plan for revision.</p>

	Zearn is being used by most teachers. Math intervention is being done by Rti teachers (push in and pull out). Math training completed by identifying essential standards. Teachers will get a planning day with a math expert from the county office of ed. Words of the Week-math vocabulary.
