Convene Meeting & Review Agenda	Patrick convened meeting-voted to accept minutes from 1/23 meeting.	Minutes Approved unanimously
Public Input	Noemi shared two drafts of magnets for attendance line (leopard head or pencil design).	Noemi will work further to create a design with elements of both visuals.
Site safety Plan Update + Security & Open Items	Angela shared we usually have a fire drill goal. District has trained staff on Run/Hide/Defend, and drill will be coming up in March. District has very comprehensive training and preparation for Disaster. Appendices has checklist for safety/awareness to make sure school is up to code and prepared during summer break. Angela preps classrooms at the beginning of the school year. Site Hazards survey: how often should we be updating?	Patrick asked if there was a communication piece that could be given to parents re: what to do in event of major earthquake. Parents are going to be invited to our Disaster Drill Run-through, and a summary will be pushed out to parents in Spotlights. Moving into next year, safety issues with construction that will be going on. Could we have a safety committee to support Angela?
Facilities Planning Update	Speech/Intervention will store materials in library. YMCA and BTB will be in 2 new portables in the back of the school. Most of the work will be done on MPR, and tearing down pods. Angela is looking into designs for a multi-use space for band, makers space, indoor PE. Etc.	
Beautiful Day Update	Angela met with Robert Clark and reviewed Beautiful Day as it relates to site construction. Some input with landscaping might conflict, so focus will be on mural (outer walls of the computer lab) and updates within the classroom. Waiting on details re: new announcement system.	
Site Goals Update	Culture Update: Angela spoke about school culture work. We have a parent doing the Project Cornerstone readings. Student Council gave feedback to Angela. Angela is working with instructional coaches to provide professional development on positive teacher language for Lunch duty supervisors. Angela shared new documentation process for classroom/playground to office, and pro-active vs. reactive process in classrooms. Lunch/Recess Balance: Kinder parent had concerns about balance time, and Angela met with Kinder Team to discuss options to build in "Wiggle Time" in the instructional day.

The District is working on a Strategic Plan based on DQR feedback (5 year plan).</p> <p>What message do we want to send to District? Shellie Roehrs spoke about concerns regarding Challenge students and keeping them engaged.</p>	<p>LCAP link went out in Spotlights.</p> <p>Patrick suggested we need more professional development to support teachers, before rolling out the new Language Arts curriculum.</p> <p>We spoke about how important it is for the PD to be thoughtfully scheduled (longer holiday break or shorter chunks of time off.)</p> <p>Modified year schedule would be optimal.</p>
